

General provisions of the 3rd International Children and Youth Music Festival

"Laudate Pueri"

AIMS AND TASKS OF THE FESTIVAL

1. To bring together choristers of Lithuanian music schools and children from Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia playing music in the Suzuki method.
2. To provide master classes for choristers and improve competences of the teaching staff by organizing seminar "Development of phrasing and choral training" with Linas Balandis (Lithuania).
3. To perform music together and to have a new experience of combining children's choirs and children's orchestra: concerts of soloists and ensembles, the final concert of the orchestra and choirs.

TIME AND PLACE

4. March 7, 2020 at Kaunas School of Sacred Music (M. Valanciaus Str. 8) and Kaunas State Philharmonic (E. Ozeskienės Str. 12) - violinists and cellists,
5. At Aula Magna of Vytautas Magnus University (Gimnazijos Str. 7) – choristers,
6. The final concert will be held at Kaunas State Philharmonic (E. Ozeskienės Str. 12).

J. S. Bach. Minuet I (book III, C-dur, with cellos)
May Song – German Folk Song (D-dur, with cellos)
Wind Song – Lithuanian Folk Song (first A-dur, then D-dur, with cellos)
G. F. Handel. Chorus from "Judas Maccabaeus" (orchestra and choirs)
J. Elberdin. Laudate pueri (orchestra and choirs).
